Enterprise Electronics Corporation (EEC) Team Chosen to Modernize the Swedish Weather Radar Network

ENTERPRISE, AL, June 15, 2012 - EEC, together with the Swedish defense and security company Saab, has received a six-year contract from the Swedish Meteorological and Hydrological Institute (SMHI) and the Swedish Defense Materiel Administration (FMV) for the period 2012-2017. The contract includes the modernization of all twelve weather radar stations in Sweden and the order value, including options, is estimated to be worth SEK 100 million (USD \$13.8M).

Under the terms of the contract, the EEC/ Saab team will upgrade all twelve weather radar stations in Sweden to state-of-the-art technology that includes Simultaneous Dual Polarization (SIDPOL®) capability. The new EEC patented SIDPOL® technology provides the tools for better weather detection and classification and greatly improves radar rainfall estimations.

"This award further demonstrates that EEC is recognized as the world market leader in weather related products with strong representation in more than 80 countries. The EEC team continues to lead the world in the development of innovative radar technologies and forecasting tools for the future. We look forward to working with our long term partners at Saab to modernize the Swedish weather radar network," said the President of EEC.

"We are updating the Swedish weather radar network with the latest EEC technology guaranteeing improved system performance for many years to come. Coordinating the project is the organization SWERAD, collaboration between SMHI, FMV and the Swedish Armed Forces, that was established to ensure the efficient operation of Sweden's weather radar network. The contract will run for six years (2012-2017) with options for a further three years.
